Hi everyone! As the Christmas holiday season is approaching fast, we are eating plump turkey with all the fixings, breads, candies and cookies that aren't usually in our diets. Here are a few tips you can be mindful of to help the "Christmas Binge" Here are some tips for eating healthily during the holidays:



- Plan ahead: Eat breakfast, lunch, and snacks throughout the day, and have a small snack before events. Skipping meals can lead to overeating.
- Eat mindfully: Avoid multitasking while eating, as this can lead to overeating.
- Drink water: Drink lots of water to stay hydrated and energized.
- Eat smaller portions: Eat smaller portions throughout the day to avoid overeating.
- Be selective: Choose white meat without the skin, and limit gravy and cream sauces.
- Cook separately: Cook stuffing in a separate dish from the meat to reduce the risk of food poisoning.
- · Serve plain: Serve baked potatoes, yams, and steamed vegetables plain instead of in a casserole.


