Did You Know... July Fun Facts!

- July was an important time for the space race of the '60s.
 The first crewed mission to the Moon, the Apollo 11
 Mission, launched on July 16, 1969. Four days later, on July 20, 1969, Neil Armstrong made history by taking the first step on the Moon while declaring, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind!"
- The first U.S. postage stamps went on sale on July 1, 1847.
- It was in July that the rabies vaccine was first successfully given to a patient. The French microbiologist Louis Pasteur administered the vaccine to a nine-year-old, Joseph Meister, on July 6, 1885. The child had been bitten by a rabid dog, and Louis Pasteur, unsure whether the vaccine would be successful, decided it was worth testing. Fortunately for the boy, it worked!
- In 1933, on July 7, construction began on one of Minnesota's most iconic landmarks - the Stone Arch Bridge in Minneapolis. The bridge was originally built to support the transportation of flour and lumber across the Mississippi River, but today it is primarily used as a pedestrian crossing.
- The Philadelphia Zoo, the first zoo in the U.S., opened on July 1, 1874.

Residents and Families of Fremont Village -

The Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Minnesota Board on Aging (MBA) are conducting resident quality of life and family satisfaction surveys in licensed assisted living (AL) communities across the state. DHS and MBA have been directed to complete this work by the Minnesota Legislature under Minnesota Statute 256B.439.

DHS and MBA have contracted with Vital Research (Vital) to conduct these surveys. The Family Satisfaction Surveys will be mailed out from DHS on behalf of Vital. The Resident Quality of Life Surveys will be conducted on Tuesday July 15th by a group of specially trained staff from Vital.
